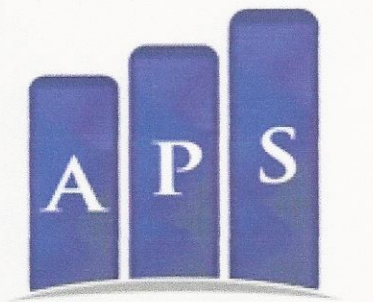


The Single Tooth Implant: The Ultimate Creative Challenge

This presentation discusses the preparation and workup to create a result that is as close to a natural replacement as possible. We will review the latest advances and evidence based data as well as a unique sequential treatment planning approach which when adhered to will lead to successful outcomes. This may be one of the most difficult challenges we face and is often not seen as such with unforeseen poor outcomes. Emphasis will be given to the use of 3D treatment planning, diagnostic workup and computer guided surgery, the use of a cast provisional and/or a provisional interim hawley device and/or a fixed provisional prosthesis to attain ideal results. Long term follow-up will be demonstrated as it relates to these topics.
